







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
# Number of Responses by Day of Week for VIOLET TWP FD

From January 01, 2015 to December 31, 2015


## EMS Responses by Day of Week



## FIRE Responses by Day of Week






# Number of Responses by Month of Year for VIOLET TWP FD

From January 01, 2015 to December 31, 2015


## EMS Responses by Month of Year




# Number of Responses by Hour of Day for VIOLET TWP FD

From January 01, 2015 to December 31, 2015


## EMS Responses by Hour of Day




# Number of Responses by Day of Month for VIOLET TWP FD
