




6. EMS & FIRE DISPATCH BY UNIT (ALL VEHICLES FROM CAD)




7. RESPONSE BY VEHICLE (FIRE & EMS FROM CAD)












15. RESPONSE BY DAY OF WEEK










16. RESPONSE BY DAY OF THE MONTH










17. RESPONSE BY MONTH OF YEAR


